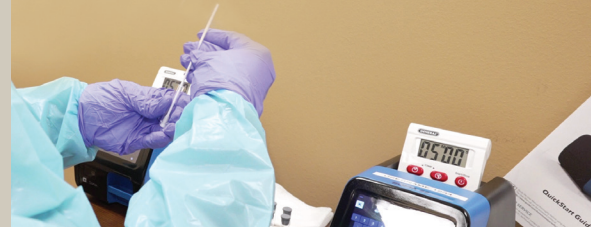


COVID TESTING

TYPE OF TESTING

Rapid Antigen

A rapid antigen test, sometimes called a rapid antigen detection test, antigen rapid test, or just a rapid test, is a rapid diagnostic test suitable for point-of-care testing that directly detects the presence or absence of an antigen. A swab is taken from the top of the nostrils or the back of the throat.

Molecular

NAAT (Nucleic Acid Amplification Test) tests work in the same way as Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) tests. They detect the RNA or genetic material of a virus and are highly accurate. A swab is taken from the top of the nostrils or the back of the throat similar to the antigen test.

COMMON QUESTIONS

Is the COVID test covered under health insurance?

Yes, most insurance providers cover the cost of the test.

Can I get a COVID test if I don't have health insurance?

Yes, we have low-cost payment options for uninsured patients.

Does Solvera offer COVID vaccines?

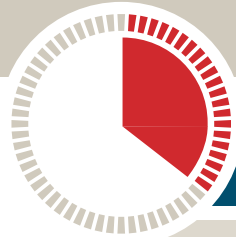
